

Title – Travel Organ Recovery Coordinator

DCIDS is dedicated to supporting families in our community who have lost loved ones by providing an opportunity to donate life through organ, tissue and eye donation.

Position Description - Travel Organ Recovery Coordinator - Works with donor families, donor hospital personnel, and transplant hospital personnel to facilitate efficient recovery of organs for transplantation. Travels to all locations of DCIDS as needed to fill in for staff absences or staffing shortages. In addition, routine rotation to all locations is expected to stay familiar with specifics of the service area. Approximate “on call” responsibilities are 10-15 days. Approximate travel is 80% of the time. Directly assists with training of new staff. Works with OPO staff members to oversee projects for the organization. Assists with hospital development duties and professional education. Assists with public education and outreach projects.

Responsibilities

- Performs “on call” responsibilities to meet the needs of donors, donor families, hospital personnel, physicians, and DCIDS. Primary "on-call" responsibilities will occur in all locations of DCIDS, including Tennessee, New Mexico, and California.
- Evaluates potential donors.
- Prepares referral and donor records.
- Assists with hospital development activities.
- Develops educational programs for staff training and orientation.
- Assists with OPO projects and research activities.
- Assists with consent and preservation duties.

Qualifications – Registered Nurse, Physician’s Assistant, Paramedic or related health care degree or licensure. One to two years in critical care preferred or equivalent medial experience in a related field.
